So here's some usefulinformation about the area around Peebles Gait.Local RootsPeebles was established as a local burgh by KingDavid I in 1152, and itstraditions live on todaymost obviously in thetown's annual BeltaneFestival, a week-longcelebration whichfeatures processions, entertainments and the Riding of the Marchesto establish the town's boundaries. The festivalis enjoyed by locals and visitors who come especially for the event. Transport Peebles is half an hour's drive from Edinburghand one hour from Glasgow. There are First Bus services to Edinburgh, a journey of around an hour, and to Penicuik, Innerleithenand Galashiels. Education and HealthKingsland PrimarySchool, around a mile and half from Peebles Gait, is a nondenominational school covering nursery ageto P7. It occupies a light, spacious new buildingwith wonderful viewsacross the River Tweed. Halyrude RC Primary School and the town's secondary school, Peebles High, is also within a short walk. Two large medical practices operate from the HayLodge Medical Centre, around a mile away, and the nearest of the town's four dentalsurgeries is even closer, in Crossland Crescent.Leisure and RecreationThe town features a25-metre swimmingpool with panoramicviews of its beautifulparkland setting besidethe Tweed, and the Leisure Centre at Gytesincludes a gym, sportshall, dance studio and an Astroturf pitch. Thearea is renowned for its fine fishing and walking, with the Tweed ValleyForest Park amongstthe many celebratedoutdoor attractions. In addition, there are several fine restaurants and traditional pubsto enjoy. Shopping Peebles was recently voted best town in Scotland for its range of independent shops. Its High Street includes newsagents, butchers, bakers, a post office, pharmacists, clothingoutlets, ironmongers, off-licences, banks, building societies andhot food takeaways, some of which arehoused in fascinating, picturesque buildings. The development is well placed for supermarket shopping with both Tesco's and Sainsbury's in the town. Arts and Entertainment Peebles Arts Festival, held at the end of August, has events for children and adults including cinema, theatre, music, visualarts, literature, crafts, workshops and walkingtours. The Eastgate Theatre, one of themain Festival venues, also presents live showsthroughout the year. Peebles has a popularmuseum, gallery and library housed in the historic Chambers Institution
