

## Peavey Classic VT Series 50w Tube Amp (120 GBP)

Rediscovered in storage, this amp was the successor to the Peavey Classic tube combo so originates from the late 70s. Never played through it myself but the online PDF manual emphasizes the amp's versatility: 2 channels; "bright" and "normal" which can be used stand-alone to create your sound using the equalization controls, or in conjunction with the Automix combiner footswitch to mix channels or run effects in series. Also master reverb and master gain controls for extra flexibility. Here's the bumf: • Made in USA - serial no. DA-605554 Export

- 2 channels: normal/bright
- 4 inputs: bright/2 x normal (high-gain + low-gain)/Automix (footswitch)
- Controls: gain (for both normal + bright channels); equalization bass, middle, treble; phase colour, rate; reverb master volume; master gain
- 2 output jacks: main speakers 8 ohms/auxiliary 4 ohms
- Rear input jack for 'Automix' combiner footswitch control buttons: selector/combiner/reverb/phase
- Remote DIN output
- Power amp input + preamp out
- Speakers: 2 x 12" no.12820PA678018
- Output 50w RMS @ 5% THD into 4ohms
- Gain 55 dB (EQ flat)
- Signal-to-noise ratio: 75 dB
- Preamp output 2 volts RMS
- All tubes 6L6GC It's gigged and, as can be seen, it could do with a clean from storage (will see to this)
