There are several different types; LCD (Liquid Crystal Display), LED (Liquid Crystal Display with LED backlighting instead of the cold-cathode technique employed by traditional LCD Televisions) and Plasma (which uses inert gases to emit pictures on screen) Televisions. LED LED televisions are one of the most expensive designs, and can be equally expensive to repair. If a scratch or crack appears, the usual cost of repair is 85% of the original cost of the television (as new). The reason for the high cost involved is largely due to the fact that the screen itself cannot simply be repaired, but it will need to be replaced. This is a complicated procedure for the repairman and an expensive repair for you as the owner to fund. Unfortunately, it may make more financial sense to buy a new LED television.
