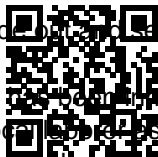

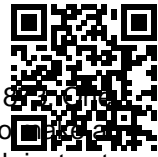

Levi's jeans have a long history, starting with the birth of the first pair of jeans in 1873. The story of a local tailor, Jacob Davis, and a customer, Levi Strauss, is a testament to the power of innovation. Davis, a tailor from New York, was asked by Strauss, a wealthy businessman, to make a pair of pants for his son that wouldn't fall apart. Davis came up with the idea to put metal rivets at the points of strain, like pocket corners and the base of the button fly. Strauss collaborated with Davis and soon the first riveted clothing was made and sold. The first pair of 'jeans' were made from traditional denim, a popular choice of fabric for men's workwear, and within a very short time the jeans were a bona fide success.

In 1873, two visionary immigrants turned denim thread and a little metal into what has become the most

popular apparel on.
