Within easy walking distance of the Park there are many shops catering for all your holiday needs, a Post Office and a large leisure park, where a golf course, swimming pool, ten-pin bowling and amusements are among the attractions. There are also many other restaurants, takeaways, public houses and amusements. Markets and car boots are

held on a regular basis at the leisure centre. There is a bus stop outside the Park where you can catch a bus to the town. Supermarkets in Burnham are found along the main A166 road. In Brean there is a town centre with a large shopping area at the top of the town (which leads up to the beach and coast) there are magnificent views of the water and Somerset coastline and the Mendips Hills. There are numerous other places of interest in the area. The New Hole, Wells Cathedral, Glastonbury Tor, Dunster Castle, the castle of the Duke of Devonshire and Longleat Animal Fun Adventure Park are all within a short driving distance.
