trees alone were £100 each, the large Phormium £125. Some of these limited plants go on sale heavily and will require more than one person to move. My advice would be to bring an extra person, and ideally a trolley to manoeuvre them into a small vehicle and take them away. The Jasmines are also clipped off the hedges so will need you to unclip them. If you please, this really is a great opportunity to get plants at a cost much less than a year ago. All the ones have grown since and are worth more. They can either be reported, left in their current pots, or you could plant them in the ground and reuse the pots. Some of which have matching feet.
