40m plug in cable with both UK and Euro fittings (10mm cable not the cheap 6mm)

A twin 6 kg bottle gas low kit (fitted) with refilling nozzle,

three fitments for all euro countries for the gas low kit

2 fire extinguishers

2 fire alarms

1 CO2 alarm all fitted

wall mounted glass (jasper conman) frames and one silver edged frame

Fan upgrade in bedroom (Croatia this year was 34 degrees so you do need it)

Euro lens adaptors for headlights

three sets of breathilzers

the legally required spare bulb kit (plus an assortment of other bulbs and fuses)

LED lights throughout the wagon (changed to improve battery life)

Conversion to three leisure batteries so without running lasts using all electrical items approx a week

before it drops to 12v (never go below the batteries don't like)

Solar panel fitted on the roof with switch over between engine and leisure batteries , so no need to charge over winter (if not used, which would be a shame coz thats a great time to van it)

Although it has a large table included I have also fitted a small wine table (as we call it) as holds a good chardonnay and glasses no problem

2 TV /dvd players (in lounge it runs on 12 v, bedroom runs on Invertor or plug in power

Invertor (1500w, ideal for an iron or hair drier) this was not then standard 800w as that was too weak so I

replaced carpets with a lot of various things just vinyl and air water you can't have the car

replaced engine with a 132 MPG and a 20 bhp motor great when going the alps
